- Joel Stewart who just returned from a prayer pilgrimage in Scotland, returns to Cambodia this week. Sina will soon take a break from work before the new year begins again at Plas Prai at the end of October. Pray for both of them and our Khmer YWAM partners (also taking their breaks) to be refreshed in the Lord during this time.
- Pray for our upcoming Annual Field Conference from September 29th to October 4th.
 Pray for the team working with the children and the training team who are coming to facilitate several church-planting and leadership development workshops.
